Saturday, March 16

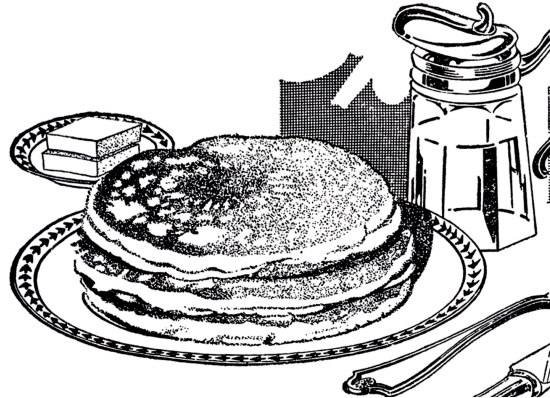
Govans-Boundary United Methodist Church, 5210 York Rd.

## **Join the Radnor Winston Community Garden**

Help decide what we will grow and other details. We jointly garden the 26 plus beds. This way we grow more, learn from each other and have company while seeding, weeding and harvesting.

### **How it works:**

We meet at the garden weekly for about 1 ½ to 2 hours to plant, weed and harvest. During peak harvest time we also do rapid fire mid-week harvests. Anyone who works that week gets a share of the harvest.

Garden prep starts in March and we close the garden in November. We ask that people make a commitment to help most weeks during the season. Together we get an amazing amount done and grow great veggies.

We also have five beds for growing for the CARES Food Pantry.

Dues: \$40 per year. What a deal! A summer (spring and fall too) of amazing super local and cannot be more fresh food!
